### **About**

Rupasri Ghosh was born and educated in West Bengal, India. She completed her schooling in Hooghly district and went on to pursue higher studies in Bengali literature from Rabindra Bharati University, Kolkata, where she obtained her Bachelor’s degree with Honours and subsequently completed her Master of Arts in Bengali Literature. She later earned her M.Phil. in Kathasahitya from Jadavpur University, Kolkata, with a dissertation titled “*Ajker Bangalijibon O Bani Basur Chhotogolpo.*”

Dr. Ghosh was awarded her Doctoral degree (Ph.D.) in Bengali Literature in 2024 from Diamond Harbour Women’s University, West Bengal, under the supervision of Dr. Sanchita Bose. The title of her doctoral thesis is “*Samayer Nirikhe ‘Desh’ Patrikar Bibartan (1980–2010)*,” which critically examines the literary, cultural, and socio-historical evolution of the iconic Bengali periodical *Desh* over three decades.

She qualified the UGC-NET examination in 2013 and has been associated with Panchur College, Kolkata, for more than a decade. She served as a Part-Time Lecturer in Bengali from August 2010 to December 2019 and has been working as a State Aided College Teacher (Category–I) since January 2020. As a dedicated educator, she teaches undergraduate students of Bengali literature, actively engages in examination-related academic responsibilities, and adopts diverse pedagogical methods to enhance student learning.

Alongside teaching, Dr. Ghosh is a poet, creative writer, and translator, with several research articles, creative translations, short stories, and poems published in reputed journals and edited volumes. She is also associated with *Shekhar Sathee*, a voluntary non-profit organization dedicated to life-centric education for underprivileged children in rural areas. In addition, she has received multiple awards in recitation at school, subdivision, district, and university levels.
